- Trios Southridge Hospital – 74-bed full-service hospital located on the Southridge campus
 - Special emergency care designations: Level I Cardiac Center, Level II Stroke Center, Level III Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center
- Trios Women’s & Children’s Hospital – 37-bed specialty hospital located on the Auburn campus along with additional healthcare services, provider practices, and urgent care services
- 11 outpatient provider-based Care Center locations
- 4 Urgent Care Centers
